Assessments

Please note that all non-native English speakers accepted to The International School of Amsterdam will be assessed for English proficiency. Students coming into Grade 10 must present Intermediate-level competency or greater.

Students entering Grades 9 and 10 may be assessed for both language proficiency and mathematics. These assessments will aid our faculties in determining the best fit for each student.

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
The following information is provided to offer an overview of offerings in language learning. These tables should be read with a few important notes in mind:
