### *Required Additional Materials*

Two complete years of school records (and a progress report for the current school year, if applicable). All records must be submitted in English or with an English translation attached. Reports may be uploaded via the Admissions Portal

Teacher recommendation form

\* Please note that a complete set of school records, the teacher recommendation form, and any student work samples must be sent to the school within three weeks of submitting the application.

**Applications for students who have received counseling, support, therapy, or who have diagnosed special educational needs should also include all relevant diagnostic reports and evaluation documentation for confidential review.**

### *Course Selection*

---

Students entering Grade 11 will be asked to complete a course selection document during / following the admissions review process.

### *Assessments*

---

All non-native English speakers accepted to The International School of Amsterdam will be assessed for English proficiency. Students coming into Grade 11 must present Advanced-level competency. Please note that EAL support is not available for students in Grade 11 and 12.

Students entering Grade 11 will be assessed in a second language and mathematics. These assessments will aid our faculties in determining the best fit for each student.
