Founded in 1964, ISA was the first school in the world to offer all three core IB programmes.

The school calendar follows a semester system with grades reported in January and June. Students attend school for 175 days. The language of instruction is English.

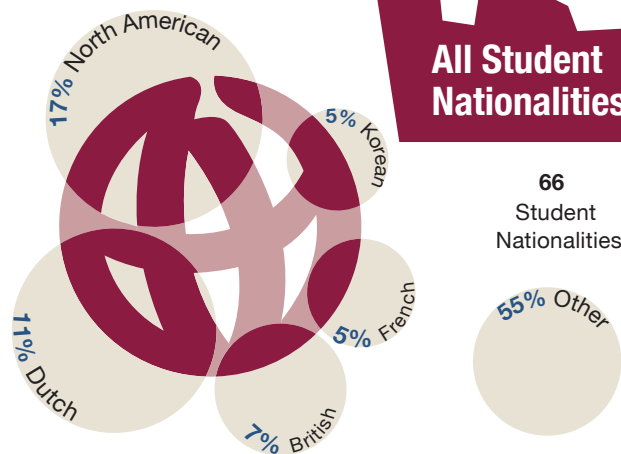
