

# **Upper School Materials**

Grades 6-12

While each course is unique and each student is encouraged to develop methods of organization that best suit his or her learning, the following list is provided to guide families and students in their purchase of supplies for the school year. From time to time, specific classes or projects require specific supplies not on this list; these will be communicated to students by their teachers.

# **Personal Technology**

- Laptop computer: As part of the Upper School one-to-one laptop programme, all students are required to bring a laptop computer to school each day. In general, the most important specifications are that the laptop must be fast enough to use within seconds, light enough to easily carry back and forth to school, and possess a powerful enough battery to be able to use it all day. Additionally, students must be able to install software on their laptop, so that they can run the course-specific software. - TI-84 PLUS CE-T Graphing Calculator or TI-84 PLUS CE-T Graphing Calculator Python Edition.: These are used in mathematics courses from grades 7-12 and for some science courses. Sixth grade students are not required to purchase this type of calculator.
